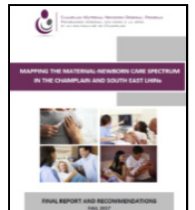

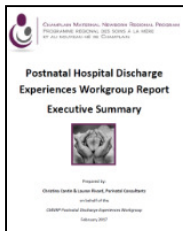
## Championing Transition of Maternal-Newborn Continuum of Care

### MAPPING THE MATERNAL-NEWBORN CARE SPECTRUM SERVICES

- 8 Focus groups with 32 Family Representatives & 155 Healthcare Providers
- 3 Priority themes emerged: Access. Coordination. Awareness.



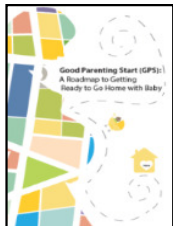
### POSTNATAL DISCHARGE



- 2 Surveys completed by:
  - 190 Pregnant Women
  - 118 Healthcare Providers

~72% of new parents suggest the 'best time to learn about postnatal care was during pregnancy'

### POSTNATAL PLAN



- 'Good Parenting Start' (GPS) tool piloted
  - 134 women engaged
  - 1 video produced



~80% thought the tool made them consider topics or situations they had not thought about!

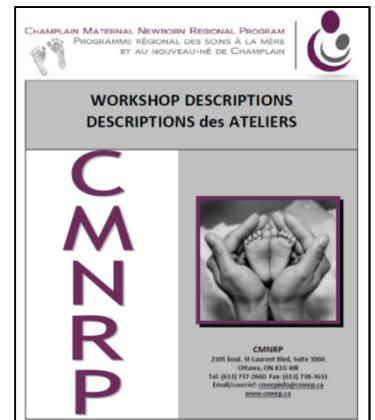
