

Dr. Paul Roumeliotis MD. CM., MPH, FRCP(C)

Certified by the American Board of Pediatrics and the Royal College of Physicians of Canada, Pediatrician Dr. Paul Roumeliotis (aka Dr. Paul) received his medical degree in 1983 at McGill University. In 1990 he founded and directed the Montreal Children's Hospital's Asthma Centre and Pediatric Consultation Centre and became a much sought-after lecturer on asthma and other pediatric issues. In 2007 he became Medical Officer of Health and Chief Executive Officer of the Eastern Ontario Health Unit.

He also holds a Masters of Public Health Degree from Johns Hopkins University School of Public Health, where he is now an Associate faculty member and is an Adjunct Professor of Pediatrics at McGill University. In January 2014, he was appointed to the Provincial Council for Maternal and Child Health.

As a health communications pioneer, he has created and produced hundreds of articles, booklets and videos/DVD's on a variety of child health issues. His web site (DR.PAUL's CHILD HEALTH AND WELLENSS INFO SITE, www.drpaul.com), the first of its kind in the world, and his health educational programs have been used by millions worldwide. His highly acclaimed groundbreaking book for parents, focusing on the importance of the first 18 months of life, BABY COME HOME, was released early in 2015. A passionate supporter of child development through the life course perspective, he believes that public health is what a community collectively does to ensure the health and wellness of its population.
